ACCESS STATEMENT

Introduction

We aim to cater for the needs of all visitors in this 14 (+2)-bed cycling barn, a 2-storey building which is in Egremont, in the stunningly beautiful Western Lakes. The following statement is a summary of our provision. If you have any specific questions about access, please call us and we will endeavour to help.

Pre-Arrival

Nearest train station is 7 miles at Whitehaven. On the Carlisle to Barrow-in-Furness route.
Bus stop within 100 yards of the cycling barn.
A local taxi service has accessible taxis if required

Arrival & Car Parking Facilities

Non restricted parking is available on Church Street, on the adjacent street.
No Access for coaches.

Main Entrance & Reception

Level main street access into building.
Emergency phone numbers for a member of staff

Public Areas – General

Good colour contrast to floor, walls and doorways throughout the building.
Well lit corridors.
Floor covering is Wood.

Public Areas – Dining Room & Lounge

Level wheel chair access to lounge and dining room.
Dining Room tables are movable.
Bench Seating is movable.

Self-catering kitchen

Level wheel chair access to self-catering kitchen.
Clear instructions for equipment use.
2 Electric cooking rings on worktop (height 900mm).
Kettle, Toaster and Microwave on worktop.

Bedrooms – Ground Floor

One 2-bed room containing one set of bunkbeds.
En-suite shower/wet room including toilet, basin and mirror.
Main light pull cord at bed head.

Bedrooms – First Floor

Staircase to 1st Floor has 1 flight with a 90 turn on step 3.
Handrails are fitted on one side.
One 6-bedded room, en-suite. Containing 3 Sets of Bunk beds.
One 4-bedded room, en-suite. Containing 2 Sets of Bunk beds.
One 2-bedded rooms, en-suite. Containing 2 Sets of Bunk beds.
Main light pull cord at door of each room.

Cycle Store – Ground Floor

Tap and Drain for washing cycling and walking equipment.

Grounds & gardens

A safe enclosed area in a walled garden.
Two bench tables with fold away seats
Non wheelchair accessible. 2 Steps to raised garden area

Additional information

Dogs are welcome by prior arrangement (service dogs are also welcome).
No smoking.
Disability awareness courses – as part of the 'Welcome Host' scheme –undertaken by our staff.
Appropriate use of maintained and non maintained emergency lighting and full hard wired fire alarm fitted.
